Oakland Deputy City Attorney to advise on municipal law issues with League of CA Cities

OAKLAND – Deputy City Attorney Kiran Jain, a lawyer in the Land Use & Development Unit of the Oakland City Attorney's Office, has been appointed to a 2-year term on the League of California Cities' Municipal Law Institute Committee.

Committee members are responsible for acting as a resource to the state legislature and judiciary in the development of municipal law, promoting an analysis of municipal law issues through scholarly research and integrating the study of municipal law in law school curricula.

Jain, a graduate of Georgetown University law school and Columbia University, has worked for the Oakland City Attorney's Office since December 2007. She was recently elected to serve as a director of the Asian Law Caucus, the nation's first legal and civil rights organization serving low-income Asian Pacific American communities. She currently serves as president of the South Asian Bar Association of Northern California, and is a former director and officer of the Bar Association of San Francisco's Barristers Club.

The Municipal Law Institute Committee also conducts an annual symposium on municipal law issues in conjunction with the Public Law Research Institute at Hastings College of Law.
